




The Keston


The Keston either uses structural steel sections for large uninterrupted spans or a self-supporting aluminium glazing system for narrower spans. The simple design of the roof and supporting structure facilitates changes of height and direction.

Available Shapes









Dual Pitch

Brings the eaves down on either side creating greater protection in open areas.

Lean-to

Generally used where the canopy is up against a building, removing any potential problem with inaccessible gutters.

Walkway

Narrower and lighter weight sections

Cantilever

Great for walkways or against buildings where a second run of columns is not possible.

Gull Wing

Central column run with the addition of a valley gutter.

Sizes

The maximum width for the Keston is around 7m but each canopy is fabricated to suit the clients requirements.

Cladding Options:

Polycarbonate - Flame Retardant (Class 1) Structured Opal (opaque) or Clear fixed into a two part Aluminium Glazing Bar with rubber gaskets to allow for the thermal expansion and secure fixing of the roofing sheets.

Others available - Waterproof PVC fabric, profiled steel, glass

Proportional Guarantees:

Framework - 25 years against structural failure.

Polycarbonate - 10 years against discolouration through sunlight. Fabric - 10 years against premature degradation through sunlight.

Standard Finish:

Unless stated otherwise all structures are shot blast, zinc primed, and powder coated to any standard BS or RAL Classic colour.

Rainwater Goods

Unless stated otherwise colour coded Aluminium gutters are included as standard with downpipes terminating at ground level with a shoe.
